ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING THE TOWN OF OCEAN VIEW CAPITAL EXPENDITURE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 2023 – 2027.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Ocean View adopted on April 12, 2022, a revision of the capital expenditures budget for fiscal years ending on April 30, 2023-2027; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Ocean View has determined that it is appropriate to amend and restate the capital expenditures budget for fiscal years ending on April 30, 2023-2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF OCEAN VIEW:

Section 1. The revised capital expenditures budget for fiscal years ending on April 30, 2023-2027, as adopted by ordinance on April 12, 2022, is amended as set forth in the schedule attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The amended and restated capital expenditures budget for fiscal years ending on April 30, 2023-2027, is as follows:

Projects and funding sources are being amended for the fiscal year ending 4/30/2023.

Purchase of the Berzins Property

At an Executive Session held during the Town Council Meeting on September 13, 2022, the Town Manager was given approval by Council to move forward with the purchase of the Berzins Property at the corner of Muddy Neck and Double Bridges Roads for the purposes of Open Space (Berzins Natural Area and Park). The total purchase price was \$503,546 and funded from the APRA Fund (\$210,293), Sussex County Excess Transfer Tax grant (\$288,253) and General Fund (\$5,000).

Country Village / Country Estates Drainage Project

At the June 2022 Council meeting, the Council approved the request for additional funding necessary to award and complete the project totaling \$218,664. Funding was available from the completed projects (SR26 Bike Lane \$24,923 and OVHS Sidewalk \$10,400), Contingency (\$51,275) and the Street Repair & Replacement Trust (\$132,006).

At the April 2023 Council meeting, the Council approved the request for additional funding necessary to complete the project totaling \$61,500 from the Street Repair & Replacement Trust.

Hudson Avenue Pipe Culvert Replacement Project

At the November 2022 Council meeting, the Council approved the request for additional funding necessary to award and complete the project totaling \$58,152 from Contingency.

At the April 2023 Council meeting, the Council approved the request for additional funding necessary to complete the project totaling \$32,500 from the Street Repair & Replacement Trust.
