## West (from SR 26) and Muddy Neck Road Improvements

The improvements to West Ave (from SR 26/Muddy Neck Road from to Beaver Dam Road are planned to begin this September by DelDOT are to include:

Mill and overlay, New signing and pavement markings, dedicated bike lanes, and new crosswalk markings were applicable.

#### **Bond Bill Funding- Great News!**

With the close of the State's FY24 Budget Year last week the State Bond Bill Community Reinvestment fund (CRF) Awarded the <u>Town of Ocean View</u> \$89,950 for Open Space Acquisition in association with our May 10<sup>th</sup> submission to the joint committee on capital improvements. Appreciation for the support of Senator Hocker and Representative Gray in our award of these funds will be sent!

In addition, the <u>Historic Village in Ocean View</u>, was awarded fundings totaling **\$90,000** for flooring installation of Hall's Store, Landscaping improvements, Tunnel-West House Exterior repairs and preservation and a website overhaul.

#### Pickle Ball

We continue to consider and evaluate options for the location of pickle ball courts in Town, giving consideration to having adeqate parking, and understanding the sound concerns often raised. In addition, we are discussing how courts would be managed with neighboring communities sharing concerns that courts are often used by non-residents, understanding that managing usage by residents only would be difficult. No surveys will be conducted at this time as we continue to evaluate options.


#### **Grant Submissions**

Last week I submitted a Delmarva Power Sustainable Communities Grant application for \$10,000 in association with adding an outdoor classroom/meeting space to the Berzins Natural Area. We expect to hear about the outcome of the submission this fall.

I am currently working on an FY24 Submission for a DNREC Outdoor Recreation and Parks Trail (ORPT) matching grant for the Berzins property to fund restroom facilities at the site. You may recall that we were awarded an FY23 ORPT grant totalling \$60,000 for various amenities originally planned at the site.


