# Miscellaneous

- Chief McLaughlin developed a four-part School Resource Officer (SRO) Program for Lord
  Baltimore Elementary School. The SRO will enhance safety & security, enforce the law, teach,
  and mentor students. Chief McLaughlin and Councilman Cobb presented the SRO Program to
  the IRSD Financial Committee Meeting.
- Chief McLaughlin toured the Bridge Clinic in Georgetown. The clinic provides service, to include screening and referrals to treatment for opioid and other substance abuse disorders and mental health disorders.

- OVPD participated in the OV Church of Christ Vacation Bible School.
- OVPD provided security assistance for the Mariner's Bethel Church Vacation Bible School.
- The annual inventory was completed for equipment obtained from the Federal LESO Program.
- The AT&T upgrade for cellular and data communications was completed at 201 Central. There was no cost for this project. All costs were covered by AT&T.
- Sergeant Carter met with representatives of Advantec to initiate the planned installation of the electronic door access system at 32 West Ave.
- Additional security surveillance cameras were installed in John West Park.
- The OVPD hosted a weeklong Solo Officer Response to Active Shooter Incidents class.
- The police department submitted a grant request for \$32,235.14 to the State Fund to Combat Violent Crime. Funds from the grant will support the addition of a new narcotic's canine unit, upgraded ballistic panels for ballistic vests, a laptop computer, and \$10,000 for overtime for drug investigations and crime deterrence.
- The OVPD participated in the Overdose Awareness Candlelight Ceremony on August 31<sup>st</sup> on the Circle in Georgetown.
- In response to complaints of unlawful commercial truck traffic on Central Avenue, OVPD increased enforcement. Additionally, OVPD requested and received assistance from the Delaware State Police Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Team. The state police team conducted two enforcement events in the OV area over the summer.
- The OVPD with assistance from the DEA Taskforce concluded a lengthy investigation into the sale of heroin and fentanyl from a home on West Ave. The target of the investigation was arrested and large quantities of drugs and money were seized.
